Calvin Smith and Daren ? Briefed committee on some ideas for the design of Skatepark components. Warren has submitted these ideas to two Skatepark design companies. A friend of the local skaters gave them an estimate of \$7000 to \$9000 for the concrete pad. The committee decided to concentrate on getting the pad completed. Laing will contact several concrete contractors and try to get more estimates. Cost will be minimized with as much volunteer help as possible. Rokicki suggested that a sign be considered for the Skatepark that would thank any who have contributed money and labor to the project. If business know of this they may be more inticed to contribute.

Park Guidelines: Township Clerk Mary Gettings presented the committee with some park guidelines that they would like to be considered by the committee.
The committee and Gettings went over the guidelines. The result was a more simplified set of guidelines. Gettings will present these to the full Township Board at their next meeting.
